Their engineers looked at the walls and offered to provide the labor to repair/replace these, however SPWAA would have to cover the cost of materials for the repairs to about 500 feet of wall. They will give us an estimate on the cost for this. The money for this would have to come out of the Improvement Fund. The Tacoma Rainiers have offered sponsorship or other help with our club.
